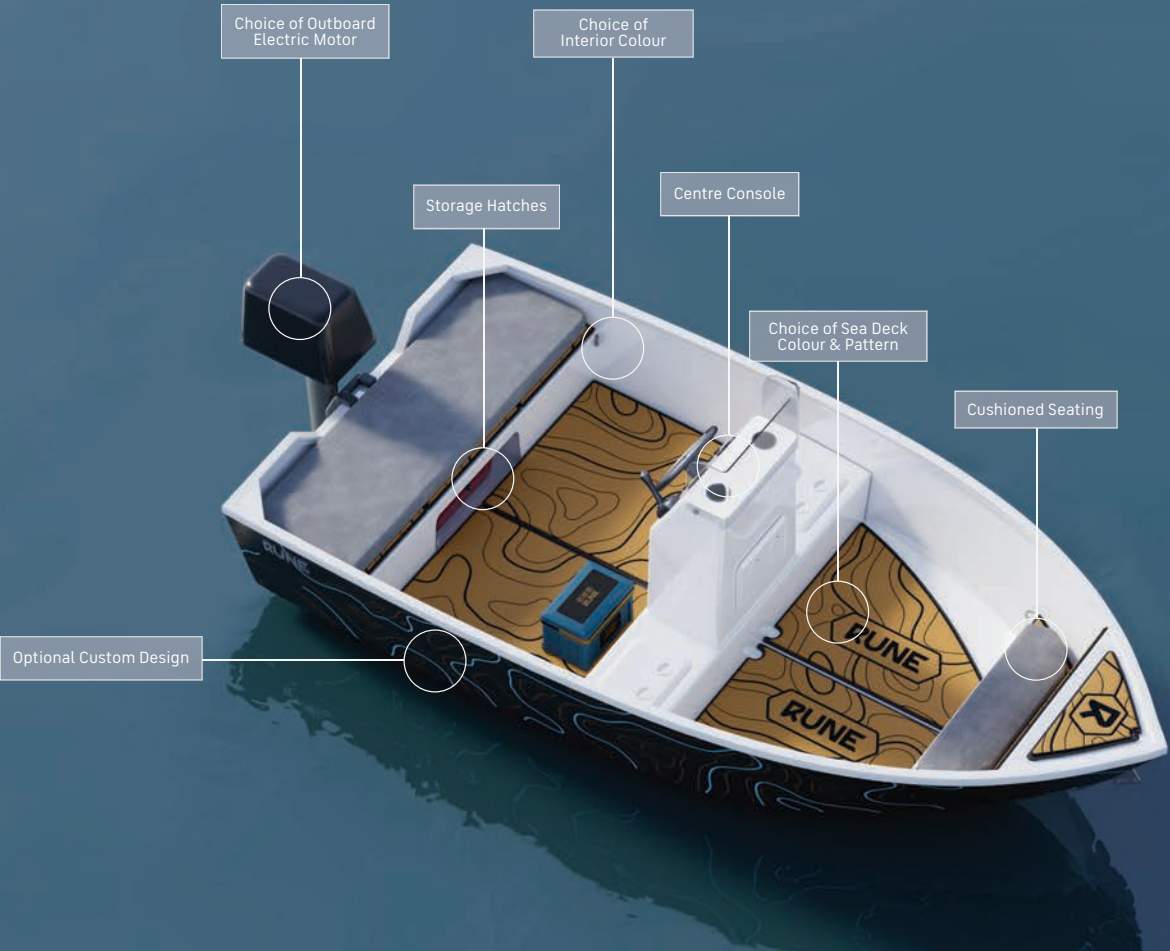
To meet a force of nature, you need a feat of engineering.

With a rigid aluminium hull at just 98 kg, a RUNE boat is lightweight in every way except lifespan.

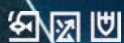
